AS WELL AS ALL-STATE TEAMS IN ALL CLASSES. ALSO WE ARE CHANGING THE ALL-STATE GAME AND WILL NOW HAVE A GAME FOR ALL CLASSES.
- 5. Membership makes you eligible for our Coach of the Year awards, on the district and state level.
- 6. Member schools (those with a school membership) a catered meal for their team if they make the state tournament. We provided 15 meals last year.
- 7. Members receive weekly playbooks during the season as well as monthly newsletters that keeps coaches updated on the game.
